## Scrappy Block

For (1) 9" block Light background

Turquoise
Fabric A Cut (2) $10^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip
Cut (2) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (A2)
Cut (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ rectangles (A3)
Fabric B Cut (1) 10 " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

3 Coloured Scraps
Grey area Cut (1 from each colour) 5 " x $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles


Block Layout


## Step 1

Lay out fabric strips as shown and sew them together, set seams and press seams in one direction. The strip should measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide. Trim up to $5^{\prime \prime}$ wide, then cut in half, to make (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Sew the $51 / 2 "$ strips together
Cut the strip set in half lengthwise

## Step 2

Rotate 1st strip, and layout the strip set as shown and sew together, set seams and press as shown.

Rotate $1^{\text {st }}$ strip, sew on 10 " (B) strip Press seam to centre


Add on either side the $10 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric (A1) rectangles and press seams as shown


Square up your block to measure $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
16 blocks will make a 38 " $\times 38$ " square table topper.
