

# “Abundance” Table Topper

Finishes Size: 30” Round

Please read all instructions prior to starting. All seams are ¼” unless otherwise specified

## Fabric Requirements

.80m	Grunge™ Winter White	top
.80m	Grunge™ Winter White	backing
.80m	Moda™ Bias–Hunter	bias binding
1m	Thermore™ Batting	
1.2M	Double Side Fusible	
1 FQ	Moda’s Wool™ – F5020W Goldstar	Sunflower
1 FQ	Moda’s Wool™ – F5019W Mustard Plaid	Sunflower centres
1 FQ	Moda’s Wool™ – F5026W Houndstooth	leaves
	Pencil	
	16” String	
	Cardboard	

## Step 1 – background and backing

Cut 2 – 32” Squares from the Cream Grunge – 1 for the top and 1 for the backing

Cut 1 – 32” square of batting

Sandwich and quilt the entire square. Once quilted, fold in half and then into quarters. Tie the 16” string to the Pencil. Pin the end of the string to the fold and draw a ¼ circle with the pencil. Cut along the pencil line, making a circle. Trim if needed so the circle measures 30” round. Sew on the binding.

## Step 2 – Applique

Roughly cut out the templates and glue to the cardboard. Cut out using paper scissors.

Trace the templates onto the double sided fusible – 8 sunflowers

8 sunflower centres

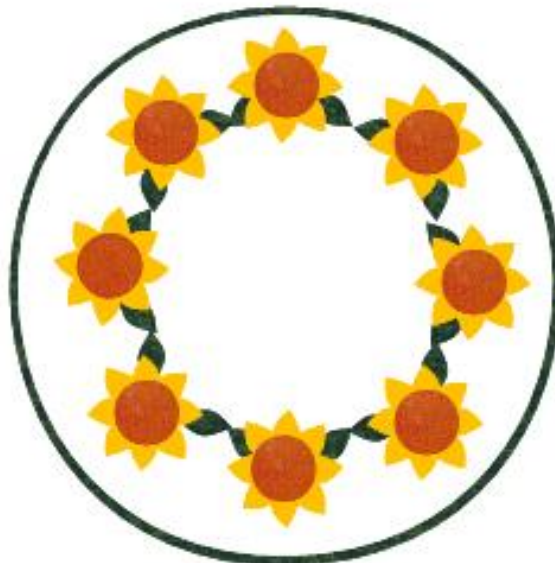
16 leaves

Press to the Wool fat quarters, let cool and cut out all appliques.

Arrange the appliques in a circle. **Hint: The tip of the sunflower petals should be 2½” in from the binding.**

Place the leaves under the sunflowers so the tips meet as shown below. Once they are in place press them.

Stitch around the centre of the flower first. Next, stitch the flowers and the leaves down using coordinating threads.
