Make a friend Day Mug Rug

Make this cute pink shirt mug rug to share with your new best friend! Using small scraps, this fun and easy block can be embellished with buttons, beads or trim. All seams are $\frac{1}{2}$ unless otherwise specified.

Block Size unfinished is 6½".

Technique: Raw Edge Applique




Background fabric 7" square White

Shirt Body 3¼" x 4¼" Pink Print (A)
Sleeves & Collar 4" square Light Pink (B,C,D,F)
Inside Collar 2" square Medium Pink (E)

Backing Fabric 7" square
Batting 7" square
Binding (1) 2½" x WOF)

Double side Fusible Web .15m

Buttons 6 very small buttons in white



Step 1 – shirt

- Trace the applique patterns onto double sided fusible web. Press the fusible to the wrong side of fabrics and cut out.
- Lay out the pieces as shown on the background 7" square, tucking the edge of the sleeves just under the shirt body. Press into place.
- Next, place the inside collar in the centre of the shirt and add the shirt collars. Press into place.

Step 2 - stitching

- Sandwich the shirt block. Using a blanket stitch, stitch down the body of the shirt.
- Using a straight stitch, stitch along the edge of the sleeves and collar.
- Next free motion stitch the background densely up to the shirt edges.
- Trim the block to measure 6½" square and add binding.
- Hand stitch on the buttons.
