

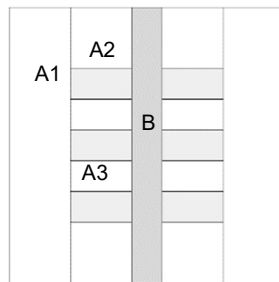
## Scrappy Block

For (1) 9" block

Light background	Fabric A	Cut (2) 10" x 2½" strip (A1)
		Cut (2) 5½" x 2½" rectangle (A2)
		Cut (2) 5½" x 1½" rectangles (A3)
Turquoise	Fabric B	Cut (1) 10" x 1½"

3 Coloured Scraps      Grey area      Cut (1 from each colour) 5" x 1½" rectangles

Block Placement



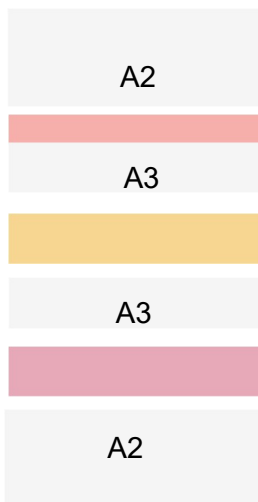
Block Layout



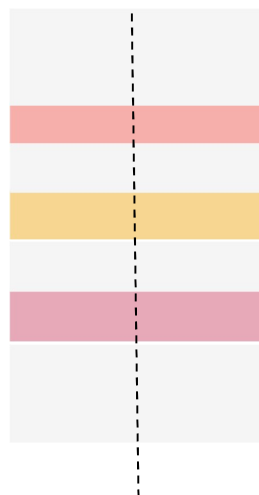
### Step 1

Lay out fabric strips as shown and sew them together, set seams and press seams in one direction. The strip should measure 5½" wide. Trim up to 5" wide, then cut in half, to make (2) 2½" strips

Sew the 5 ½" strips together



Cut the strip set in half lengthwise



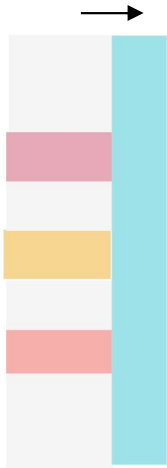
Creating (2) 2½" strip sets



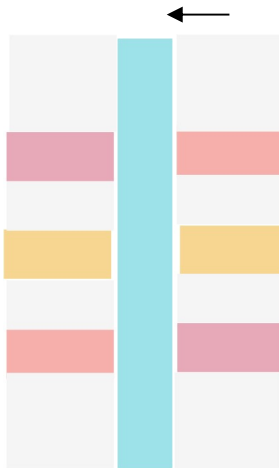
## Step 2

Rotate 1st strip, and layout the strip set as shown and sew together, set seams and press as shown.

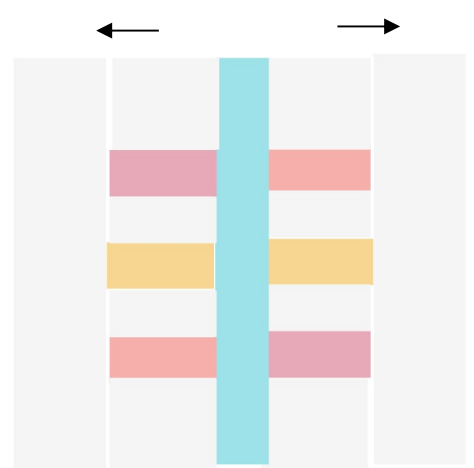
Rotate 1<sup>st</sup> strip, sew on 10" (B) strip  
Press seam to centre



Sew the 2<sup>nd</sup> strip set, press  
toward the centre



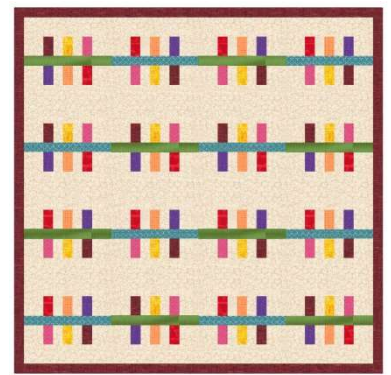
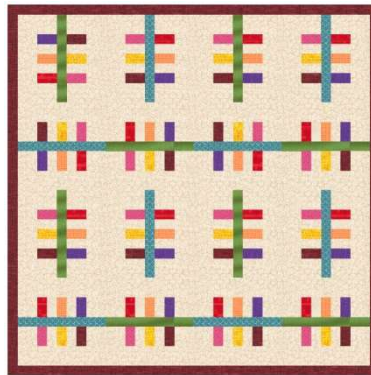
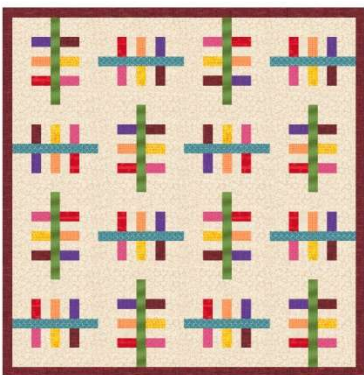
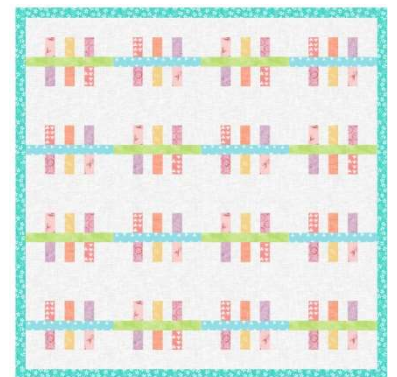
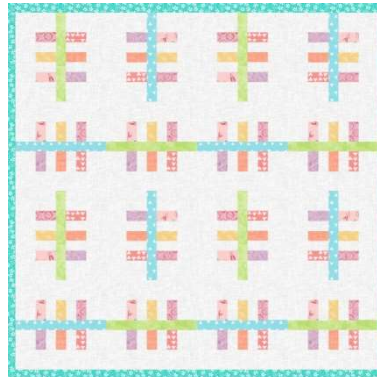
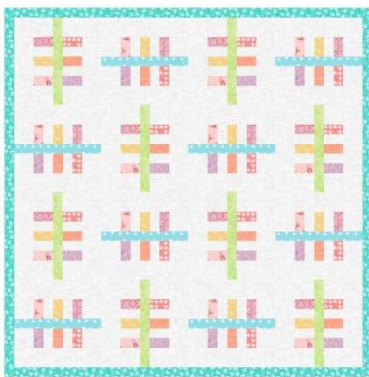
Add on either side the 10 x 2½" fabric (A1)  
rectangles and press seams as shown



Square up your block to measure 9½" square.

16 blocks will make a 38" x 38" square table topper.
