

St. Patrick's Day Mug Mat!

Finished Size – 6" x 8½"



Read all instructions before starting. All seams are ¼" unless otherwise specified.
WOF – width of fabric

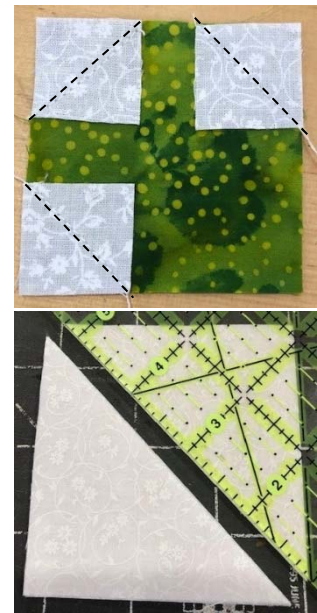
Scrap Fabric requirements (Makes 1)

Green	4 – 2½" squares 1 – 5" x ¾" strip
White	1 – 3" square 9 – 1" squares 1 – 4½" x 6" rectangle 1 – 2" X 4½" rectangle
Binding	1 – 2½" x WOF
Batting	9" x 7" batting

Step 1 – leaves

Place 3 white 1" squares right sides together on the 2½" square as shown. Stitch on the diagonal as shown in example 1. Make a total of 3.

Step 2 – stem

Cut the 3" white block in half on the diagonal as shown.

1. Centre the 5" x ¾" strip on one of the triangles and stitch using an accurate ¼" seam. (Example 2) Press seam to the white.
2. Repeat with second triangle (Example 3) Press toward the white (Example 3a)
3. Square up to 2½"

Step 3 – layout

1. Press the leaves blocks as shown and trim the excess from the corners



2. Layout at shown and sew row 1 together.

3. Sew the 2 rows together to complete the block.

Row 2



Sew the 2" x 4½" white rectangle to the bottom of the clover leaf block.
Set the seam and press to the 2" white strip.

Sew the 4½" x 6" rectangle to the left the clover leaf block set, set the seams and press.

Sandwich and quilt as desired.

Add binding and enjoy!
